## HOW DO I GET INTO THE CATALOG?

**On Campus:** login to the Coppin home page (www.coppin.edu), click on MOORE LIBRARY, then the big blue CATALOG USMAI button.

**From Home:** in your browser's address window, type http://catalog.umd.edu.

**BASIC SEARCH**— The Basic Search screen has keyword and browse searching with the most common types of searches. "Word/s anywhere", a generic keyword search, is the default search. Examples of each search type appear under the search box when you click on a particular search type. Click on "tips" and help for more information.

## REQUESTING AN ITEM

To order an item from another library, click on the yellow “request” button above the availability list. You will be prompted to log on using your library barcode number and last name. **NOTE:** You may only select an item that is not on the shelf at the library where you want to pick up the item. For example, in the above citation, you could not select a book to be picked up at Coppin—Coppin has a copy on the shelf. Next, select a campus where you want the item to be sent.

Click on the “send” button, and you will receive confirmation of your request: **“\*Item has been requested for pick up at [Library Name].”** If you get an error message, check with the Circulation or Reference staff.

## SEARCHING FOR JOURNALS
